

#### LIMITED WARRANTY TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR ELECTRIC VEHICLES

Royal Electric Vehicles LLC ("REV") hereby warrants that any new Royal Electric Vehicles purchased from REV, or any Authorized Dealer in the United States, will be free from defects in material and workmanship for THREE years from date of purchase, subject to the stated limitations. During the term of said warranty, any authorized REV service technician or REV dealer will, free of charge, repair or replace (at REV's option) any part determined to be defective by REV due to faulty workmanship or material from the factory. Parts used in warranty repairs will be warrantied for the balance of the vehicle's warranty period. All parts replaced under warranty become property of Royal Electric Vehicles LLC.

- Warranty repairs made by other than an REV Factory Service Center, or an authorized and qualified Dealer or designee.
   Warranty repairs made by other than an REV Factory Service Center or an authorized and qualified Dealer or designee shall void the Limited Warranty
- Damage or loss resulting from acts of nature, weather events, vandalism, theft, war or other circumstances over which REV
  has no control
- Any and all expenses incurred in transporting the Vehicle to and from REV or an authorized Dealer, technician, or designee for warranty service
- Warranty limited to six months on carts used for rentals or loaner carts in conjunction with other rentals such as renting
  property and a golf cart is included in property rental.
- Using any part or serviced not supplied or approved by Royal EV will void the warranty.

# QUICK REFERENCE USER GUIDE

## MAJESTY INSTRUCTIONS AND HELPFUL HINTS

#### START UP

- Always turn the cart on with the directional knob in neutral position. Wait for the screen to say ready.
   This is located at the top center of the screen and will light up green. Failing to do so will make the cart not run. A check engine light will appear. If so turn the cart off and put in neutral and then turn key back on and wait for ready sign on screen. If you start in drive or reverse turn the cart off and place in neutral then restart.
- Always come to a complete stop before shifting from forward to reverse or vice versa.
- When the cart isn't in use turn the ignition key off and remove key.

#### CHARGING

- Always charge the battery with it on and the ignition key off. The battery on/off button is on the side of
  the battery located under the front seat on drivers side and is lit up blue. In order to get to the battery,
  you must lift seat firmly from the back.
- If the cart is not in use, charge it. The cart is equipped with an intelligent charger and will automatically shut off when the battery is fully charged. When the light is solid green on the charging meter above the charge port on the cart that means the battery is full. When the light is flashing red it is still charging.
- You also have the battery life gauge on the screen but is only accurate if the cart is not plugged in.
- The cart will go into limp mode and go 9 miles per hour at 20% of battery life. This warns you to charge the cart as soon as possible since drive time is now limited.
- You cannot charge the cart when the temperature is under 40 degrees. You can ride it, but you can't charge it.
- If you are not using the cart for a few days, charge it to full and then pull the front seat up and shut the battery off (see first "Charging" bullet above). Leave the cart unplugged with the battery in the off position until ready to use cart again. This will insure that the battery will be full when you come back to the cart after a long period of time. Turn the battery back on when ready to use the cart again.
- If the charge light is flashing red & green, that indicates a charging fault and the cart is not charging.
   Contact your dealer immediately.

#### **ROUTINE MAINTENANCE AND CARE**

- The tire pressure on the cart should be 19 lbs.
- Only wash the cart with standard car wash soap and water and no abrasives.
- Use soft cotton or microfiber cloths that are clean to wipe the cart with.
- Do not spray water or liquids on battery or the display screen.
- Clean the seats with a standard interior automobile interior cleaner
- The rear cargo trunk is removable but you must disconnect the tag light wire inside the trunk.
- The cart is equipped with a standard class 2 hitch for accessories like a golf bag holder cooler and a storage rack. Max tongue weight is 225 lbs. If pulling a small trailer.
- If a cargo basket is attached the same tongue weight applies.
- Many important components are located under the back seat. Try not to spray water directly near the back seat cushion or components could be damaged.

#### STANDARD EQUIPMENT

- The cart is equipped with street legal required features.
- Headlights are on to the left of the steering column. Make sure to turn them off when the cart is not in
  use.
- The hazard flashers are to the right of the forward reverse directional knob.
- The directional switch is the knob on the dash to the right of the key switch.
- The blinkers are on the steering column and do not automatically cancel. You must cancel the blinkers manually.
- The cart is equipped with front high/low beam lights. Push the lever forward for high beams and pull back towards you for low beams.
- The horn is on the end of the blinker switch.
- The seat belts are a three point shoulder harness.
- The cart is equipped with a USB port to play music from an outside device if you don't want to use Apple Play or Bluetooth.
- The cart is equipped with a 1 amp plug for iPhone and 2.1 for a Android device.
- Charge port is located clearly under the rear seat on the rear seat body.
- The cart is equipped with daytime running lights and a illuminated grill.
- The cart is also equipped with a backup camera which will activate automatically when the cart is put into reverse.
- The cart has a locking glove compartment and storage trunk all operated by the same key (not the
  ignition key).

### SAFETY PROCEDURES AND PRECAUTIONS

- Only licensed drivers 16 years of age or older should drive the cart.
- Use due caution when turning corners. Slow down when taking corners.
- Drive the cart with the same vigilance and safety procedures as you would a car.
- Before backing up make sure all impediments or children are not in the way.
- Do not drink alcoholic beverages and drive the golf cart.
- When exiting the cart make sure the ignition key is in the off position.
